TOP TIPS FOR DOG OWNERS:

- Ensure your dog is out of the way before the postman or woman arrives
- Please keep your dog in another room before answering the door and make sure children don't open the door to the postman
- Give your dog some food or a toy to occupy them while the mail is being delivered
- Invest in a letter cage or an external letterbox 4.
- 5. Please ensure your dog is microchipped, wearing a collar and tag, and that your contact details on the tag and microchip are up to date
